Ireland is an island in the North Atlantic. It is separated from Great Britain to its east by the North Channel, the Irish Sea, and St George's Channel.

Ireland is the second-largest island of the British Isles, the third-largest in Europe, and the twentieth-largest on Earth.

Geopolitically, Ireland is divided between the Republic of Ireland (officially named Ireland), which covers five-sixths of the island, and Northern Ireland, which is part of the United Kingdom. In 2011, the population of Ireland was about 6.6 million, ranking it the second-most populous island in Europe after Great Britain.

- Students can contribute towards their living costs












Postgraduate Employment & Migration Options

 - 2 Year working visa
 - Open to graduates of Degree and Master Degree programmes
- Criteria
 - 12 month job search visa
 - 2 year contract, min salary €30,000
 - · Skilled employment

Long Term Residency

- Students who enter the Graduate Employment Scheme (GES) can seek to remain in Ireland longer than the initial 3 years covered by the GES by applying for a work permit, with the support of a company based in Ireland
- Once you are paying tax in Ireland as a full-time employee for 5 years, you can apply for long term residency


