




Malta is a wonderful study abroad destination for students who are more comfortable in English-speaking regions.

You can only work for a maximum of 20 hours per week and you must continue studying for a minimum of 15 hours per week.

In 2020, the national wage in Malta remained fixed at 777.1 € per month.
